Isn't a CSA All Vegetables? And too many beets?

No! Our CSA consists of 100% fresh, local products including milk, goat and cow cheeses, eggs, drinkable yogurt, butter, a variety of meats, lots of fruits, and even maple syrup.

Can I manage all that produce?

Yes! Sign up for our "Produce for 2" share, a truly manageable size that does not require cooking every night! We also include recipes in our weekly newsletter.

What's in a typical week's grocery basket?

It is up to you! Choose your basket from a wide variety of local foods. A typical week of produce in July: heirloom tomatoes, yellow onions, a Sweet Beauty watermelon or the best plums ever, just-picked basil, amazing garlic, new potatoes, and beets so sweet they taste like candy.

How many weeks will I receive food?

The current season runs through the week of November 19th, just before Thanksgiving week. The winter season begins the first week of December.

Where do I pick-up my food?

Our convenient pick-up locations are listed on the back of this application. Please bring re-usable bags or a box to collect your food.

What if I can't make my pick-up spot this week?

We can hold your share at Grasshoppers for 24 hours, or have a friend pick it up at your regular pick up location. Or we can donate you share.

What does "local" mean?

Sustainable and Fresh! Our food is produced on small, family farms, mostly within 130 miles of Louisville, harvested on Monday, and delivered to our warehouse in downtown Louisville either the day of or the day before your delivery.

Can I get extra food just for this week?

Having a party? Give us a call or send an e-mail, and we'll provide all the extra food you need.

What farming practices are employed?

Our products are carefully sourced and include farmers who are "certified organic", "certified natural", or chemical free. Our farmers raise their animals on pasture without antibiotics, steroids or hormones. If we ever have a conventional item, we detail the source and process in our newsletter.

Why Grasshoppers?

Farmer owned, Grasshoppers is a growing community of people like you, committed to sustainable, local food production. We support small, family farms in our area because we believe in the intrinsic value of family farming, and we believe the food these farms produce tastes better, is healthier, and is produced more sustainably.

Pastured Beef – \$ 12/delivery (biweekly deliveries)

- 1, 3 lb roast or 2 lb ground beef per delivery. Raised in the pasture, this beef has higher levels of vitamins A & E, and essential fatty acids.

Mixed Meat – \$22/delivery (biweekly deliveries)

- Approx. 4 lb of various KY proteins per delivery. For the locavore that would like to try pork, chicken, lamb, and beef.

Share prices are listed per delivery. The "Share in the Harvest" program runs through the week of November 15th. When you sign-up for a share you are committing to the entire season. To calculate your share price just multiply the delivery cost by the number of weeks remaining.

Examples:

Start the week of August 16th.

Mixed meat share: \$22.00 x 7 weeks = \$154.00 for the season

Staples Share: \$36.00 x 14 weeks = \$504.00 for the season
